Three directorship positions will be voted upon at the 2025 annual meeting of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District. One directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Governing Board member Mike Jacob representing the New South Haven directorship area. This election will be for a full four-year term. The second directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Governing Board Member Dean Efantis representing the Old South Haven directorship area. This election will be for a full four-year term. The third directorship position is currently held by Incumbent Governing Board member Theresa Dixon representing the Salt Creek Commons directorship area. This election will be for the two years remaining on the unexpired term to which she was appointed.

Interested and qualified applicants for any of the three directorship positions are invited to submit a nominating petition signed by at least five (5) freeholders from within the respective directorship areas. A candidate must be a freeholder from the directorship area for which the nominating petition is filed or the nominee of a corporate freeholder. The nominating petitions must be filed pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Conservancy Act before November 30, 2024. Nominating petitions can be filed by mailing them to the mailing address of the Twin Creeks Conservancy District which is P.O. Box 209, Wheeler, Indiana 46393. Nominating petitions that are mailed are valid only if delivered or postmarked before November 30, 2024, and if the envelope has sufficient United States Postage and is addressed to the aforementioned address.

To be qualified to hold any of the three positions of director, an individual must be qualified by knowledge and experience in matters pertaining to the development of the district. A nominee need not be a petitioner for establishment of the district. A nominee does not have to be a resident of the area of the district from which nominations are invited but must be a freeholder.
